2) Critical Suppliers Analysis


Critical Suppliers Criteria:

Norm referenced; Set the standard deviation proportion for each grade.

Graded based on the capabilities of the entire vendor pool being assessed. Base on the average score and standard deviation, If the vendor group has high capabilities the average score will be high accordingly, Thus, Norm referenced grading will have some flexibility based on the ability of the vendor segment.


5) Overall Results

- 88.78 is average score of suppliers in this evaluation
- 100.00 is highest score and 66.20 is lowest score
- 842 suppliers (86%) with outstanding performance
- 132 suppliers (14%) need to improve performance
